01) How would you describe your English in this scale from 0 to 6?



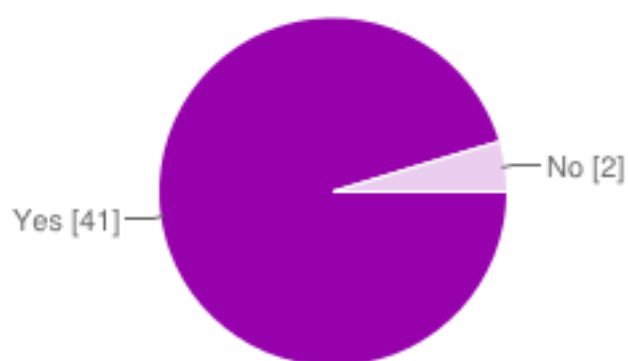

02) Why do you learn English?



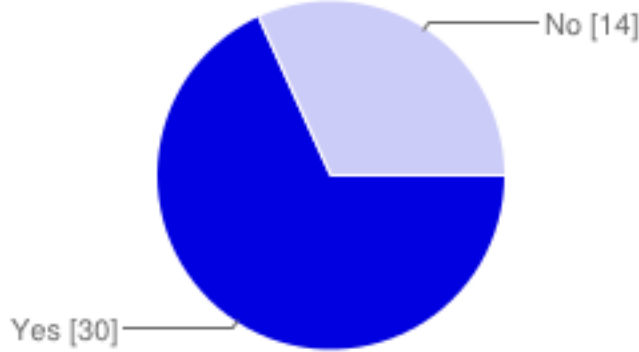

03) Do you like learning foreign languages in general?



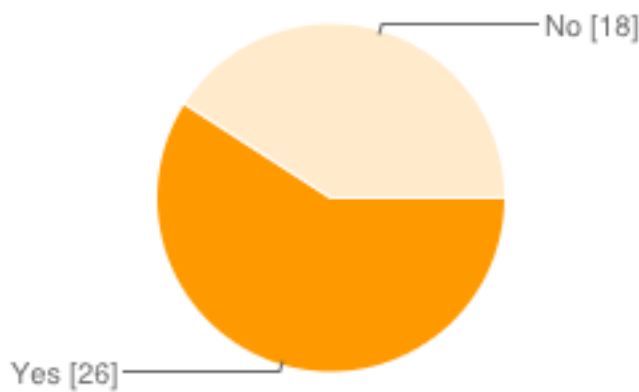

05) Do you like learning French better than English?

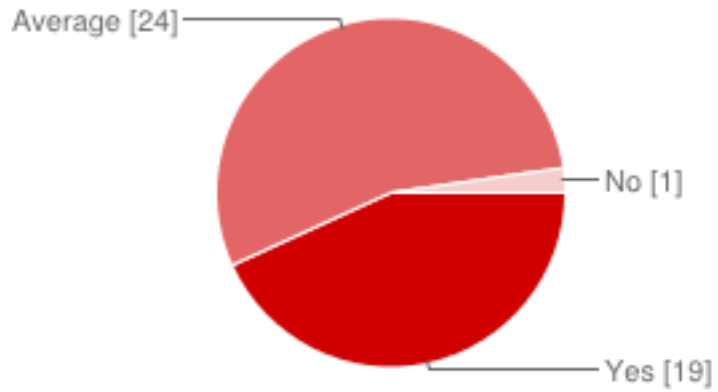

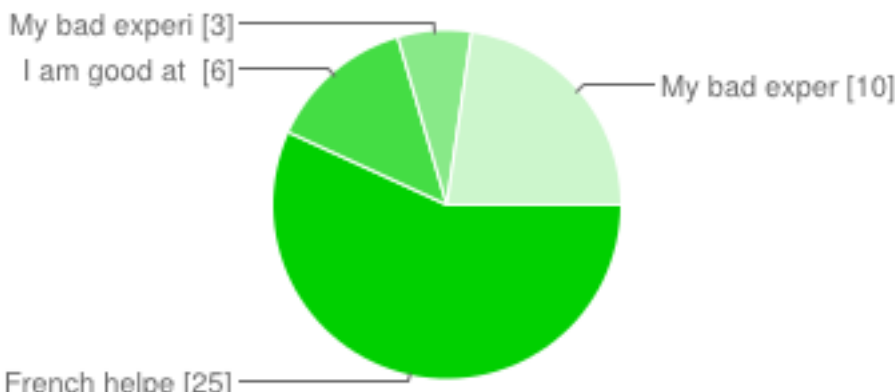

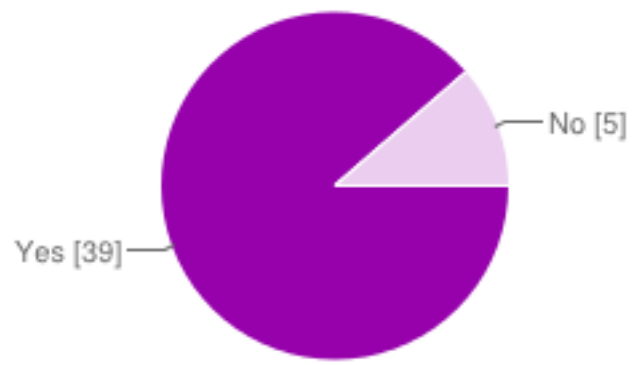

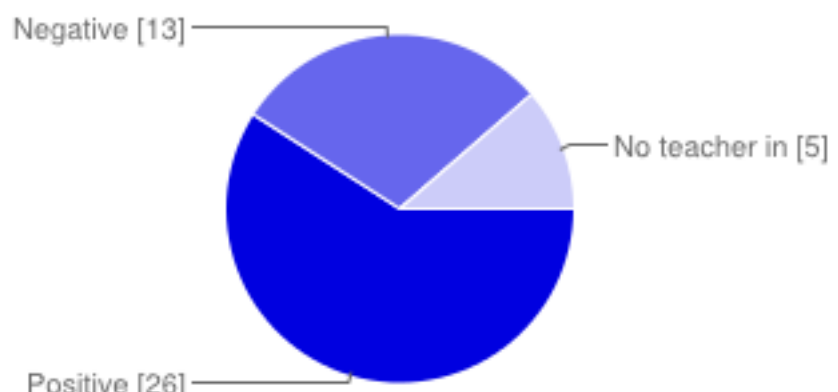

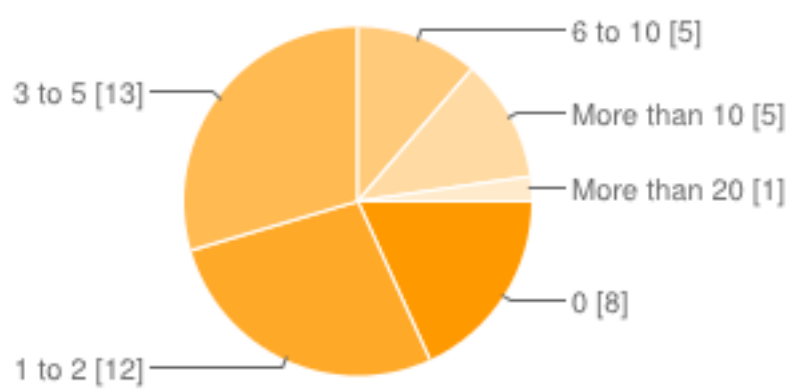

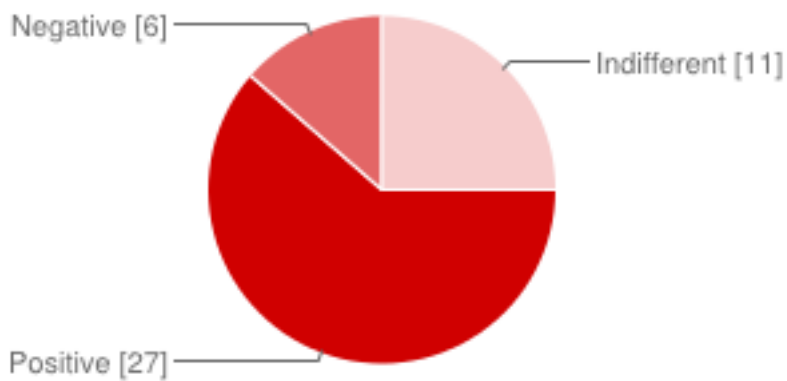

10) How many American movies do you watch per week?



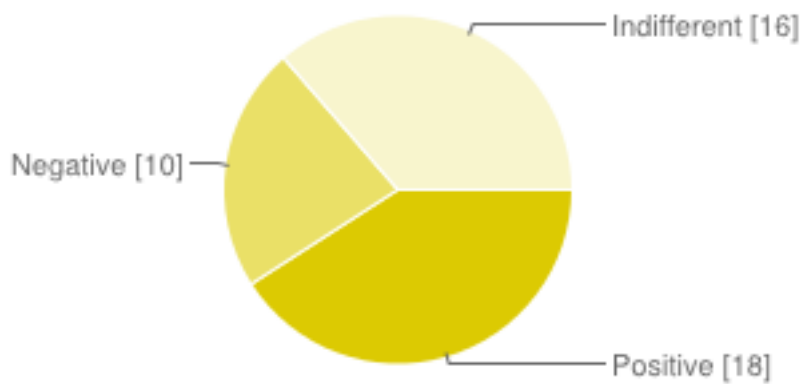

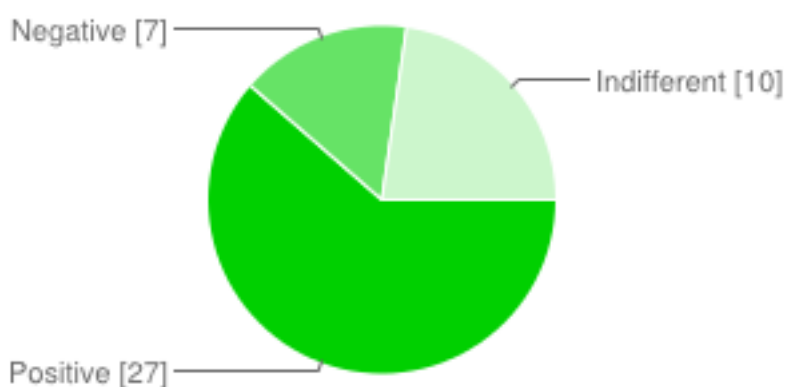

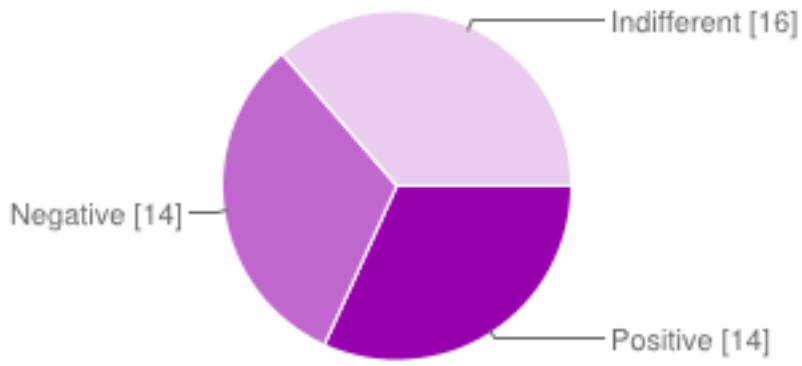

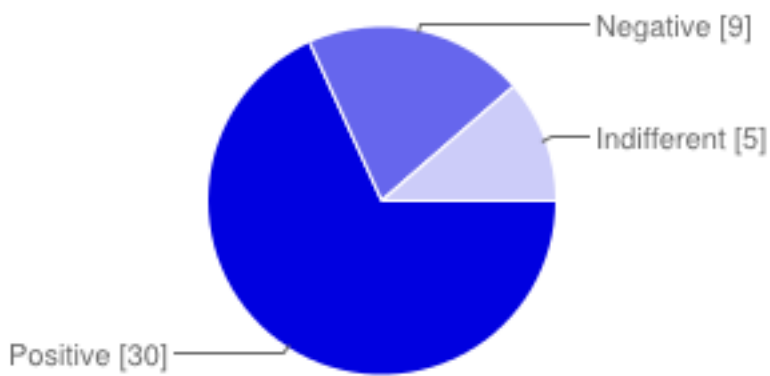

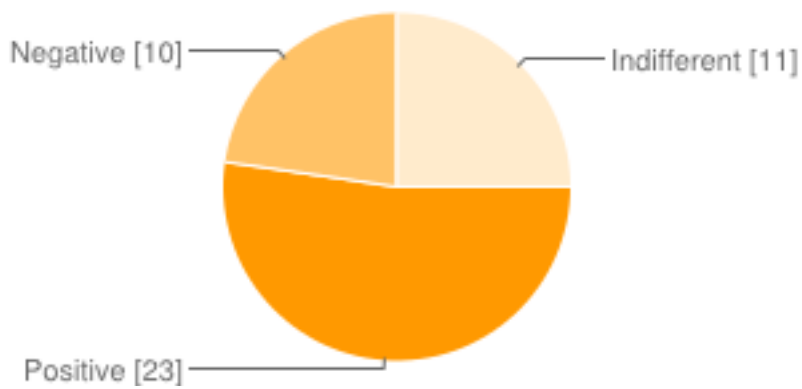

13) What do your friends and peers think of English?



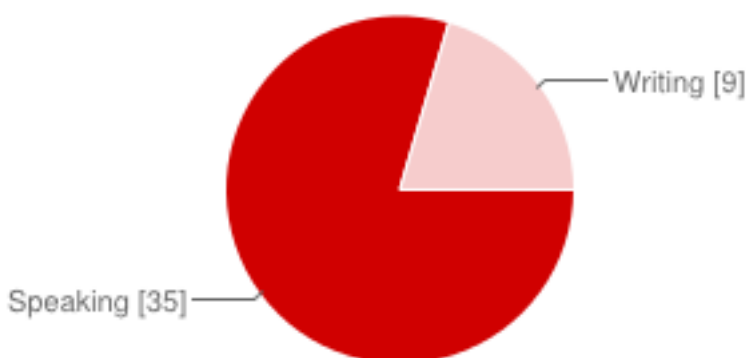

What do your friends and peers think of Western culture?



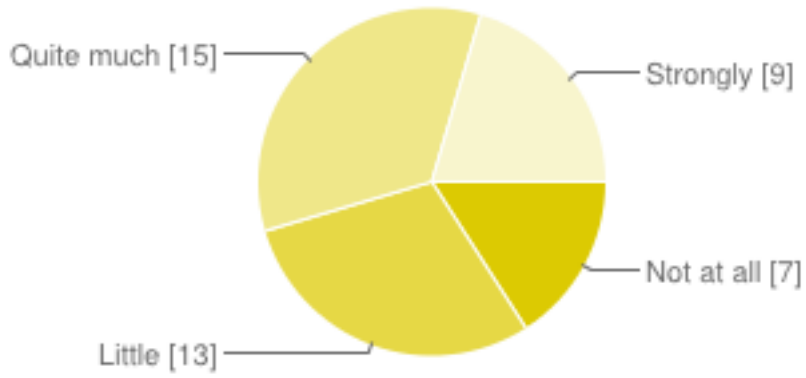

14) What is more important in learning a foreign language?



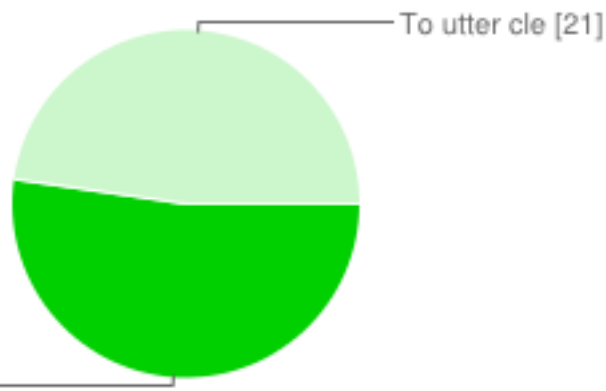

15) Do you worry about making mistakes while speaking in your English class?



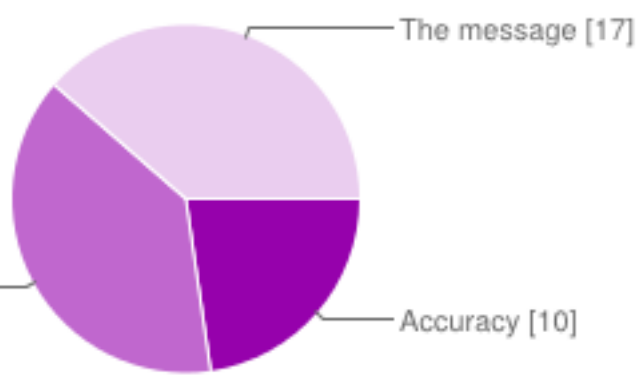

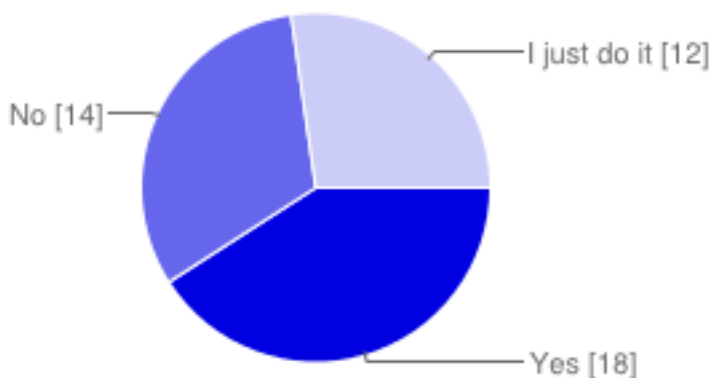
